Selecting frequent functions

Changing the time-limited room temperature

The room temperature is increased or decreased by up to 12 hrs, e.g. for a party.

- ▶ $1 \times \equiv \rightarrow$ Desired temperature $\cdots \rightarrow \oslash$
- **Time period** $\overline{\cdots} \rightarrow \bigcirc$

Switching off the heating

Heating is not required, domestic hot water generation and frost protection remain active, e.g. in the summer.

► 2 × (\equiv) → CONTROL (\oslash) → Zone 1 (....+) → (\oslash) → Heating (....+) → (\oslash) → Mode: xxx (\oslash) → Off (....+) → (\oslash)

Switching on the heating

The heating is switched on, e.g. in winter.

▶ $2 \times \textcircled{=} \rightarrow \text{CONTROL} \oslash \rightarrow \text{Zone } 1 \xrightarrow{\cdots \cdots + \bullet} \rightarrow \oslash \rightarrow \text{Heating} \xrightarrow{\cdots \cdots + \bullet} \rightarrow \oslash \rightarrow \text{Modus: Off} \oslash \rightarrow \text{Mode: Manual / Time-contr. } \bigcirc \bigcirc$

Heating up domestic hot water once

Heat up domestic hot water once outside of the set time period for domestic hot water generation or if domestic hot water generation is deactivated.

▶ $2 \times \textcircled{=} \rightarrow \text{CONTROL} \oslash \rightarrow \text{DHW boost} \underbrace{\cdots \cdots } \rightarrow \oslash \rightarrow \oslash$

Abwesenheit einstellen

Heating and domestic hot water generation are not required, frost protection remains active, e.g. for holiday times.

▶ $2 \times \equiv \rightarrow \text{Absence } \oslash \rightarrow \text{All } \odot \rightarrow \oslash$
