I live at [REDACTED] which is within the proposed Bentley Historic Core Conservation Area. Having attended the public consultation in the church last week, I can unequivocally confirm my support for this proposal.

I have lived at [REDACTED] and I can confirm that the core area that has been identified for conservation is an oasis of ancient and unspoilt buildings, woodland, footpaths and farmland, and treasured views. It has a truly fascinating and significant history, illustrating so beautifully an almost incredibly long running story of rural community. It has, and continues to be, very frightening to realise that this could be so easily destroyed and that we are on the brink of exactly this happening.

The plan recognises, officially, that this area is an almost intact medieval landscape. There can be no doubt of the deep importance and value of moving to preserve and protect this.

It is even more pressing that we address this in the face of multiple current threats and, speaking as honestly and impartially as possible, the only people who could object to this, either as a whole or in part, are those who wish to profit from building on it or industrialising it.

I feel that it is also important to stress that any suggestions to reduce the size of the proposed conservation area – for example not to include Falstaff Manor, Potash Lane and Engry Wood - would rather defeat the object of it. The proposed conservation area is the sum of all its parts – the four ancient manors - plus any reduction in its size would leave our lovely, well attended Grade II* church, and all the other listed buildings and buildings of interest in this cluster, totally exposed to immediately adjacent development.

In every respect the complete area meets the conservation area specification. It is, absolutely, *‘an area of special architectural and historic interest, the character of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance.’*

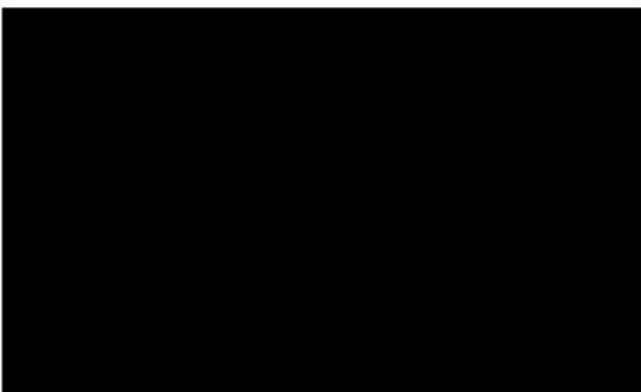

I live at [REDACTED] which is within the proposed Bentley Historic Core Conservation Area. Having attended the public consultation in the church on the 16th January, I can confirm my strong **support for this proposal**.

What I had failed to appreciate until relatively recently and brought to light by the Handforth Heritage CAAM report is the extent of Bentley's history. I now feel even more strongly that as a resident and stakeholder of this unique Suffolk time capsule I have a responsibility to ensure it is preserved and enhanced for future generations.

The CAAM report is excellent and illustrates why Bentley proposed Conservation Area is such a strong example of how listed buildings, ancient woodlands, small lanes, footpaths and farmland are all interconnected to form a rich geographic tapestry of history.

There was some suggestion by one party I spoke to at the meeting on 16th January, that the proposed Conservation Area should be potentially shrunk to an area around Bentley Church, Bentley Hall and Bentley Park. I see no merit in this suggestion. The whole of the proposed area exhibits all the characteristics as laid out in the criteria for the consideration of a Conservation Area which is '*an area of special architectural and historic interest, the character of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance.*' My personal opinion is that to exclude the various ancient woodland bordering the west of the area, or Old Hall (c.13th Century) to the north, or Maltings Farm (c.15th Century) to the east, or Falstaff Manor dating back to the 15th Century to the South, or any of the other other significant buildings and intervening historic landscapes would make no sense at all and completely undermine the scope and ambition of the Bentley Historic Core Conservation Area.

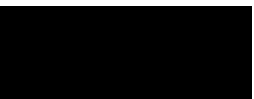

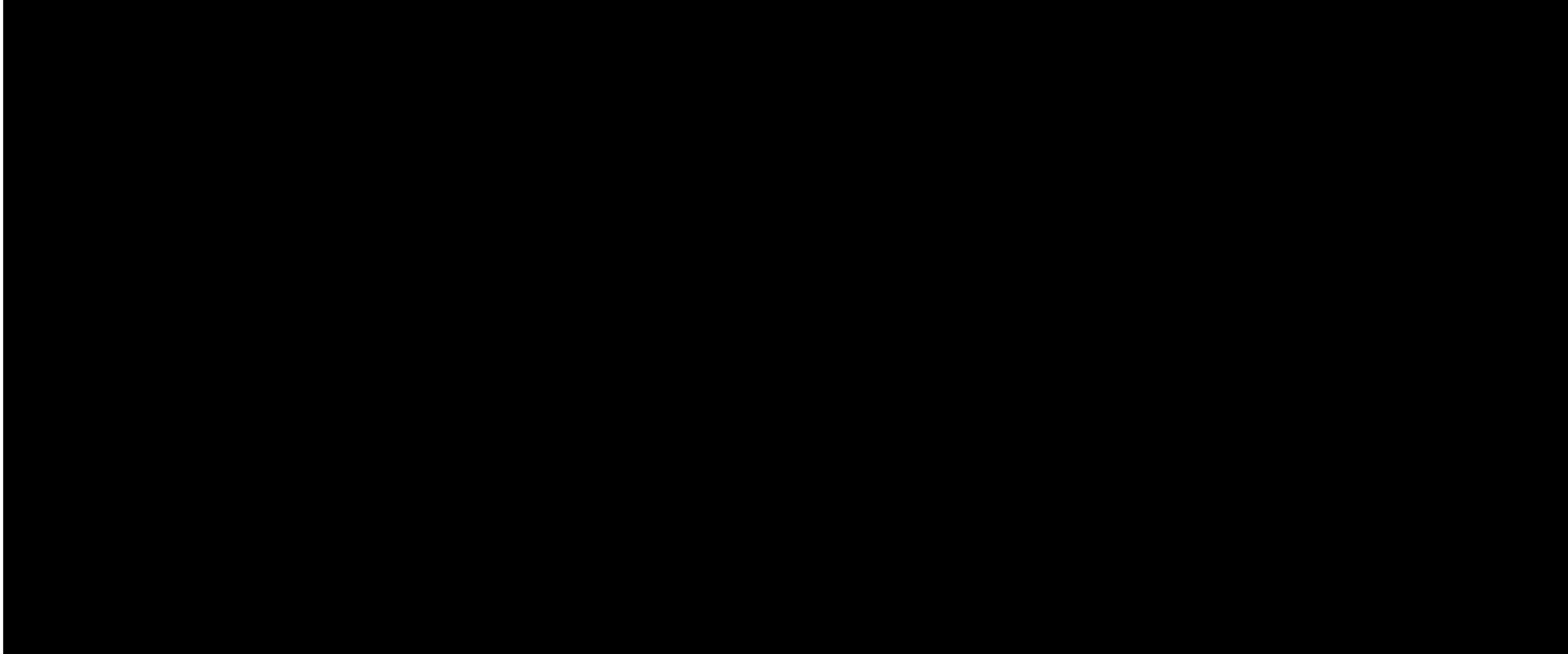
As a village and a county we are extremely lucky to have areas such as this and we must keep them exactly as they are.
