

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

**The Babergh (Reorganisation of Community Governance)
(Lawshall) Order 2023**

Made 21 September 2023

Coming into force in accordance with Article 1(2)

Babergh Council (“the Council”), in accordance with Section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 23rd January 2023.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with Section 93 of the Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient.

The Council, in accordance with Section 100 of the Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that Section.

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 86 and 240(10) of the Act.

1. Citation and Commencement

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Babergh (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Lawshall) Order 2023.
- (2) It shall come into force on the day that it is made.

2. Interpretation

In this Order –

“District” means the District of Babergh;

“existing” means existing on the date this Order is made;

“map” means the map marked “Map referred to in the Babergh (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Lawshall) Order 2023” and deposited in accordance with Section 96(4) of the Act, and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number;

"registration officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, Section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

3. Effect of Order

This Order has effect subject to any agreement under Section 99 of the Act (agreements about incidental matters) relevant to any provision of this Order.

4. Number of parish councillors for the parish of Lawshall

The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Lawshall shall be 9.


5. Electoral Register

The registration officer for the District shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.
