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
- The village lies outside of Flood Zones 2 and 3 but the potential for surface water flooding still exists.
- DG5 data for external and internal sewer flooding incidents has been obtained from Anglian Water which shows sewer flooding
- BGS geology and EA groundwater vulnerability maps show the settlement to be underlain by a minor aquifer of high and intermediate vulnerability, and so the potential for groundwater

All potential land bid sites lie outside of Flood Zones 2 and 3.

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Bacton is a village in the west of Mid Suffolk with a population of approximately 1250. It is a key service centre on the district and has a shop, post office, schools, GP and bus service.

Bacton is situated outside of Flood Zones 2, 3a and 3b in 2107. Pluvial and groundwater flooding remain as potential
