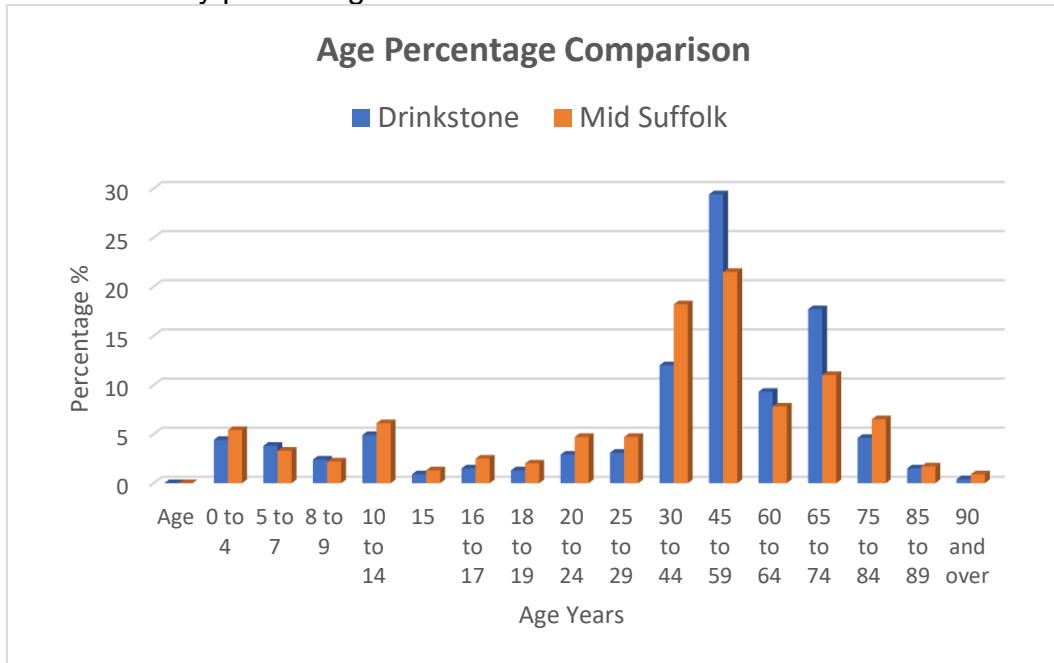

2.2 Comparison with Mid Suffolk area by number and percentage.

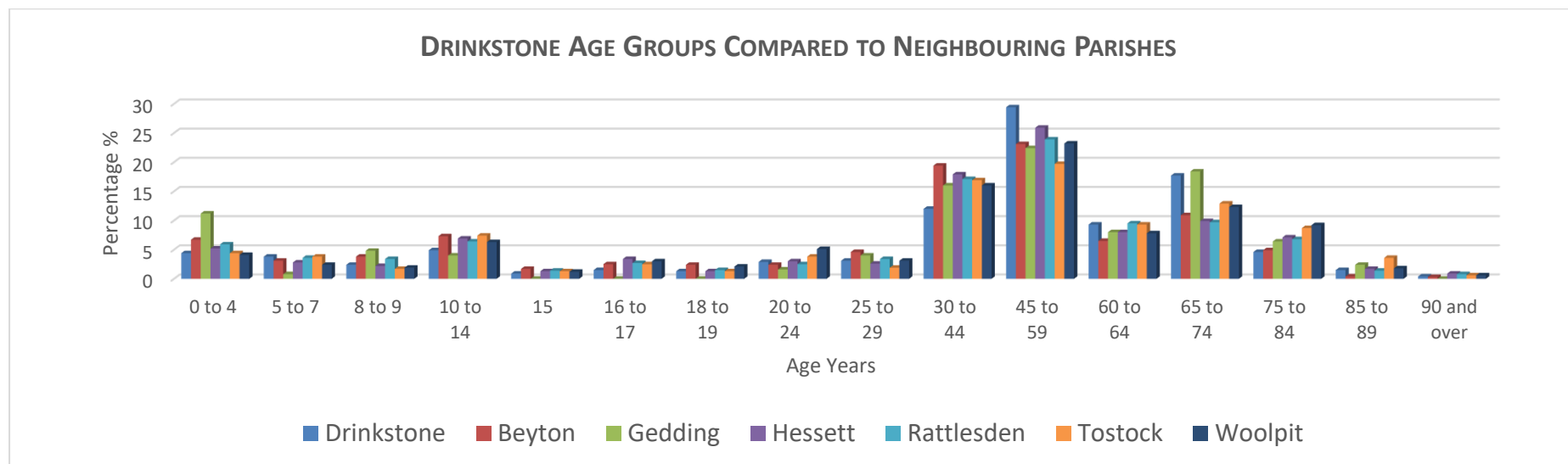

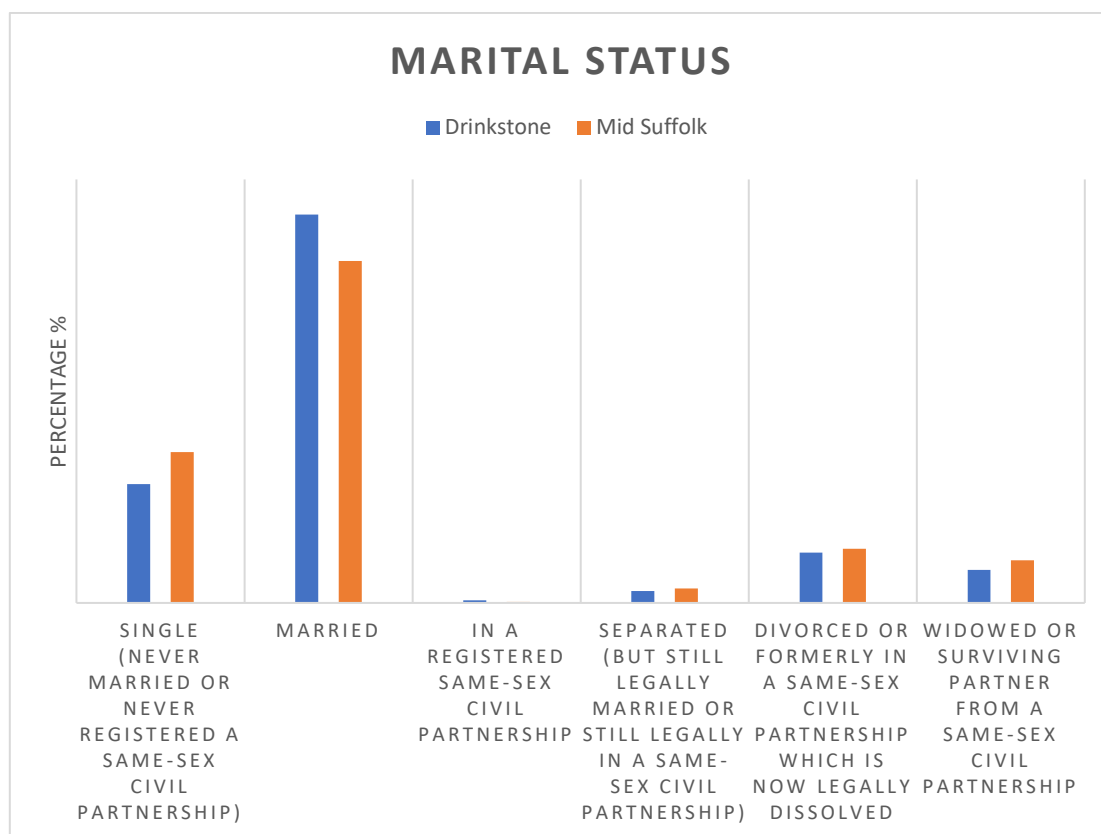

3.1. The table shows that Drinkstone has a higher percentage of married persons than in the Mid Suffolk area.

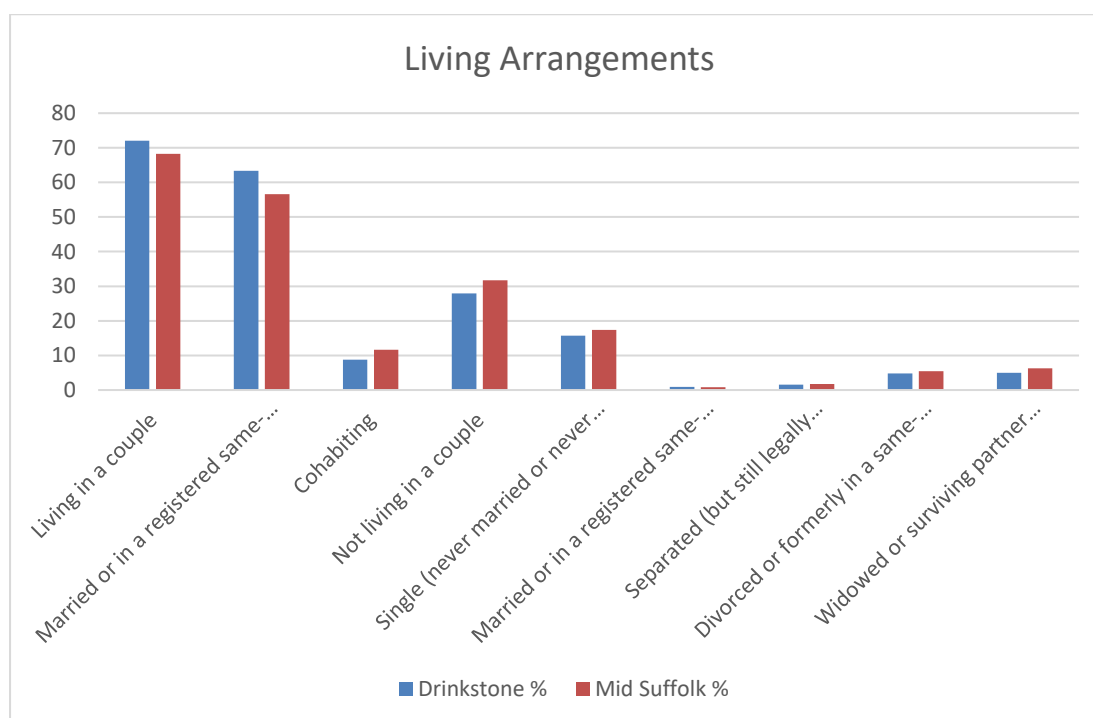

4.1. The tables show that there are more persons in Drinkstone living as couples than in the Mid Suffolk area.

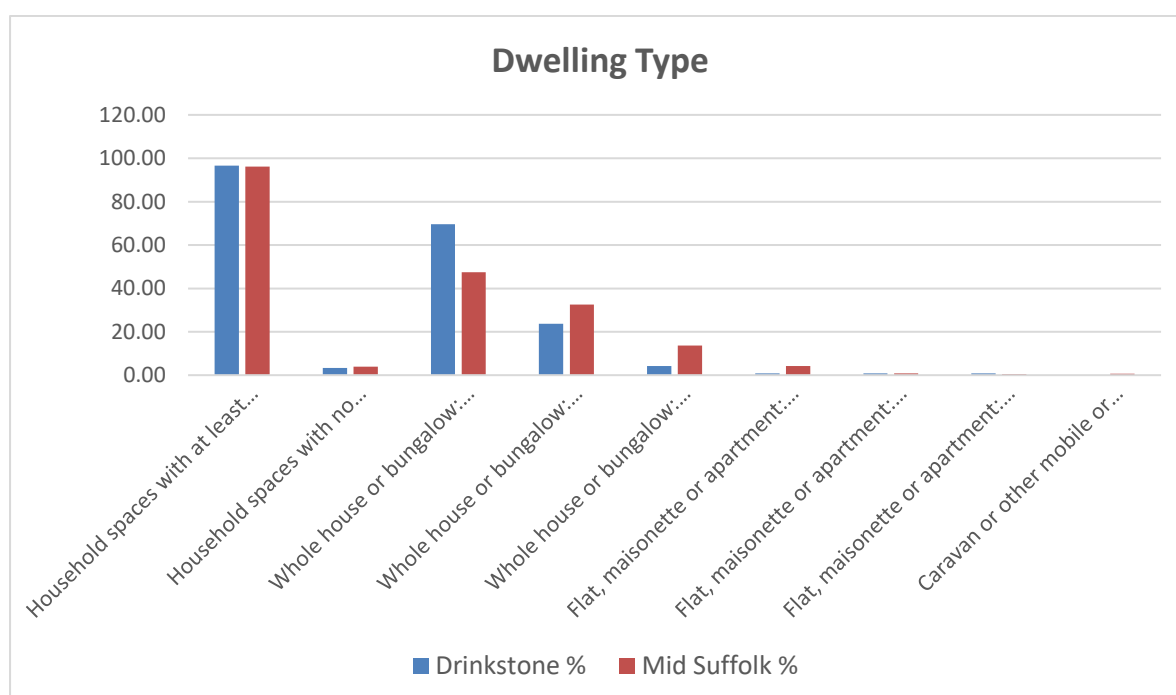

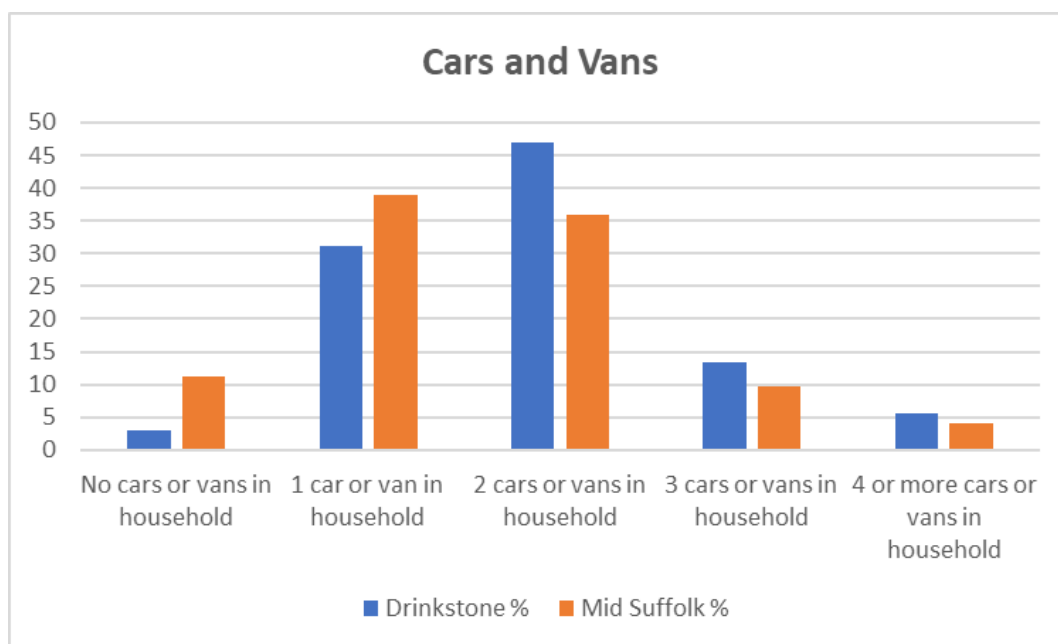


## 6. Car or van availability

6.1. There is a very clear difference in vehicle availability between Drinkstone and Mid Suffolk overall.

6.2. Where a car or van is available Drinkstone has more vehicles in each category than Mid Suffolk. The “2 cars or vans” category is the largest category where Drinkstone exceeds Mid Suffolk by more than 11%.

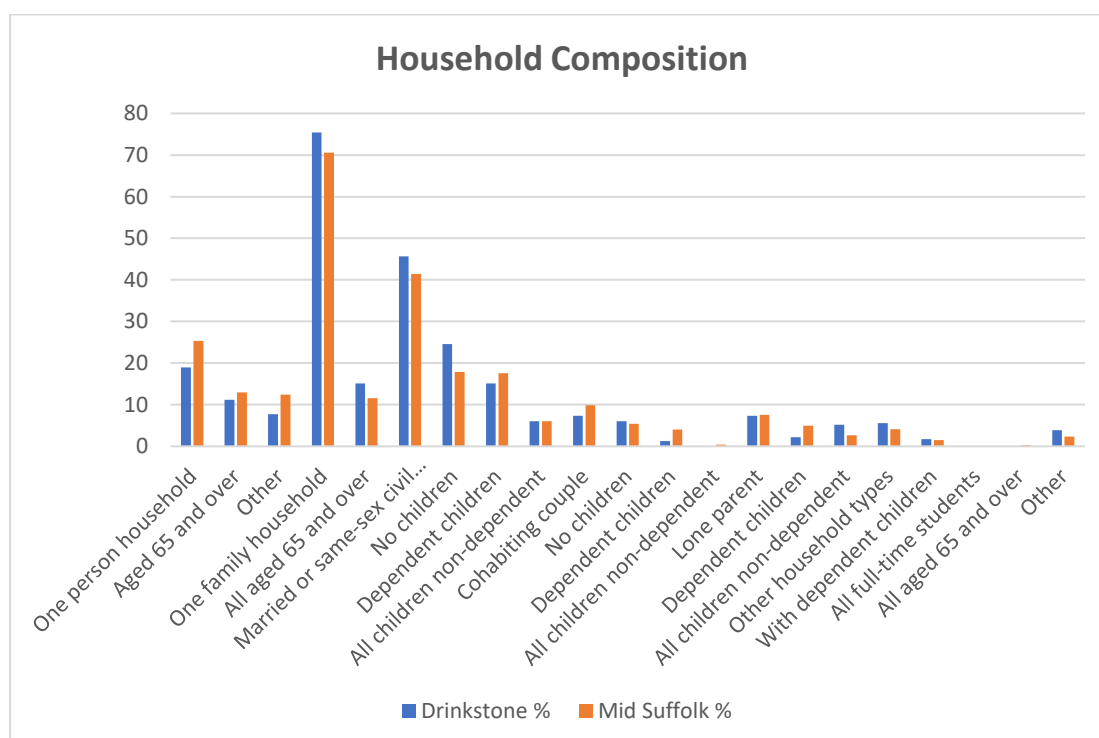

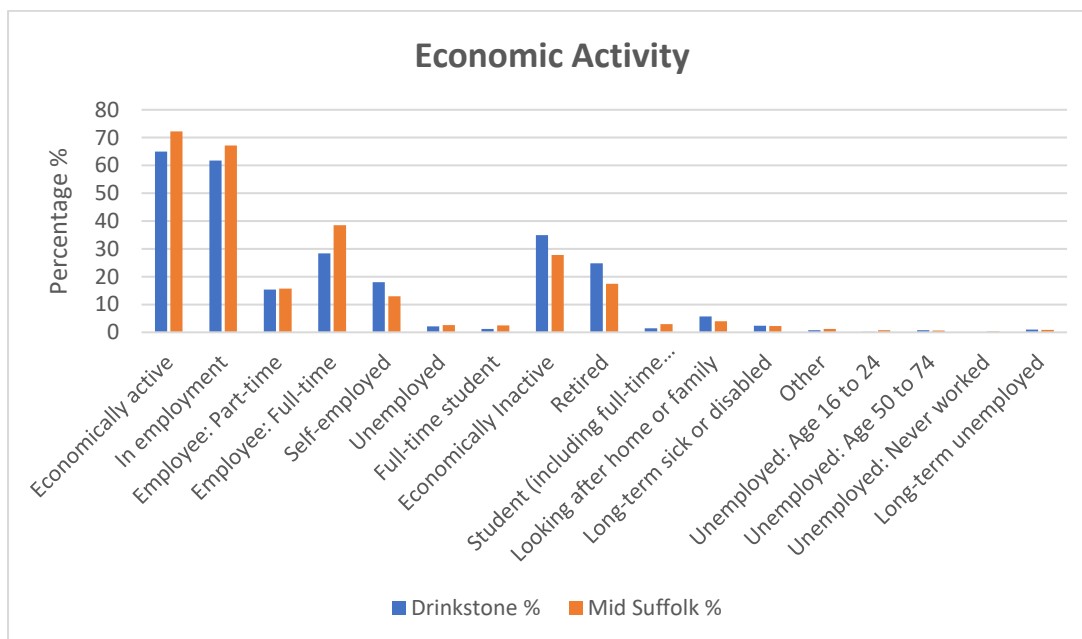


**8. Economic Activity** (All usual residents aged 16 to 74 in employment the week before the census)

8.2. A higher percentage of “Self Employed” live in Drinkstone.

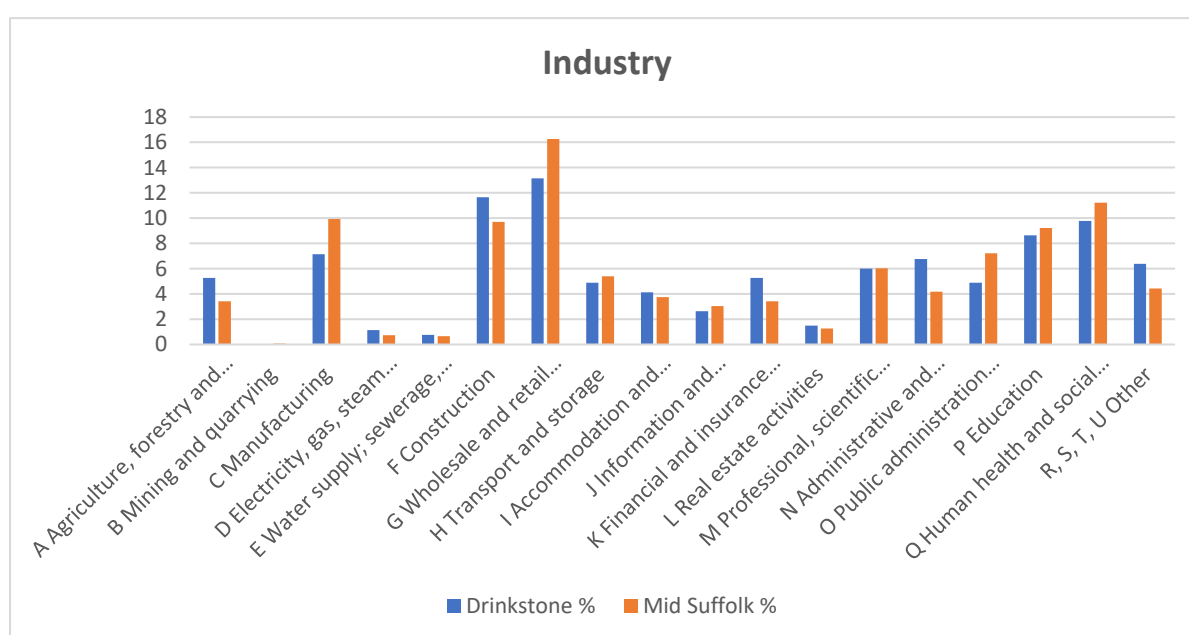

9.1. Drinkstone residents are working more in Agriculture, Construction, Financial and Administrative roles than those in the Mid Suffolk area.

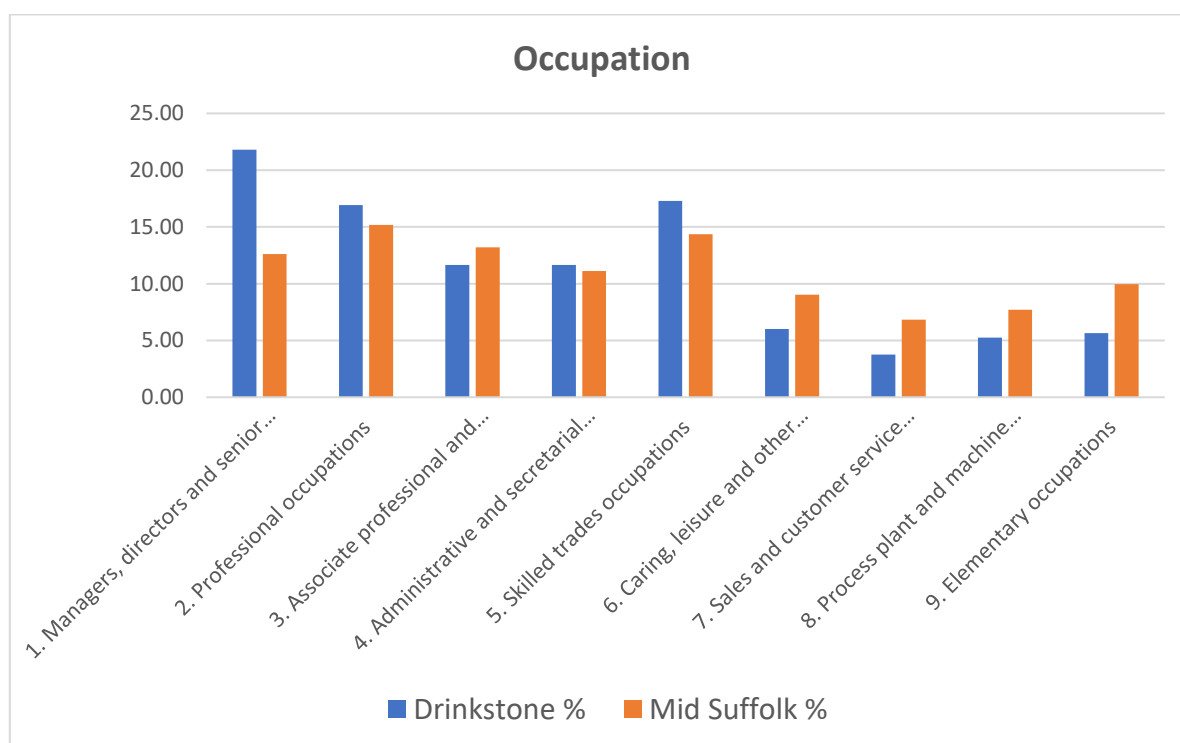
